

## ARE YOUR CCTV SIGNS FIT FOR PURPOSE ?



**The 1998 Data Protection Act requires all CCTV installations to have suitable signage advising of CCTV surveillance & its purpose.**

The ICO have published the paragraph below in their 2008 Code of Practice.

*“ Clear and prominent signs are particularly important where the cameras themselves are very discreet. Signs should be more prominent and frequent where it would otherwise be less obvious to people that they are on CCTV.*

Signs should:

- be clearly visible and readable;
- contain details of the organisation operating the system, the purpose for using CCTV
- who to contact about the scheme (where these things are not obvious to those being monitored);
- be an appropriate size depending on context, for example, whether they are viewed by pedestrians or car drivers. ”

Rather than offering a one sign fits all policy, our CCTV signs can be printed or engraved on many backgrounds, including coloured foamex, brushed aluminium, stainless steel & polished brass, combining statutory information with client logos & details in many typestyles & designs.
